

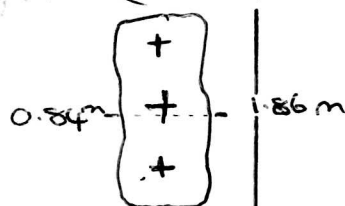
For Comment on burials see 1832 & 1836

St Llwni's church.
Church still in normal
use. It was affiliated in 1291
to the Priory of Saint John,
Carmarthen.

John Septon is the first
recorded Priest about 1399.
There are 2 stained glass windows.
The walls are plastered apart from
the stone surrounding the archway
of the west wall of the tower.
Tiled floor in altar, and slated
floor elsewhere.

The church has a blocked
up south window in the tower
and has a carved stone in the
west porch / tower, and an altar
stone with 3 crosses on it.
