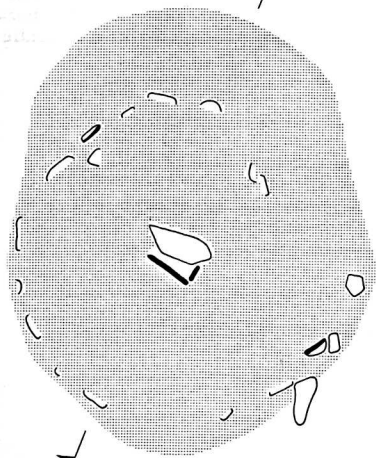


8. Blaen-Glasffrwd 4 (fig. 7; surveyed 1979) SN 76 SE

7708 6310

Located 90 m to the SW of Blaen Glasffrwd 3 (No. 7, above) and in a similar position, but in a slight hollow. The cairn consists of unconsolidated mixed grade stones and measures 14.5 m (N-S)  $\times$  11.5 m with a maximum height of 0.8 m. The oval shape of the mound is probably due to the dumping of material on the N. A ring of leaning and falling orthostatic slabs protrudes from the surface of the cairn and has a diameter of 10 m. At least 15 orthostats are visible. A large cist of massive slabs lies at the centre of the cairn.
