


Dolgamfa (fig. 10: surveyed 1977) SN 77 NW

located at c. 300 m OD on level ground on a spur overlooking a deep gorge of the Afon Rheidol with open views to the E and S. The site consists of an oval ring of orthostatic slabs and blocks and measures 5 m (NW-SE) x 4 m. Although 12 stones were recorded by Sansbury (1932, 13) only 11 are now visible, the tallest having a height of 0.75 m. The level interior is turf-covered and has a height of no more than 0.15 m above the exterior. A small heather-covered bank lies a few metres to the N and could be robbing spoil derived from the site. A ruined building lies c. 120 m to the NE.
