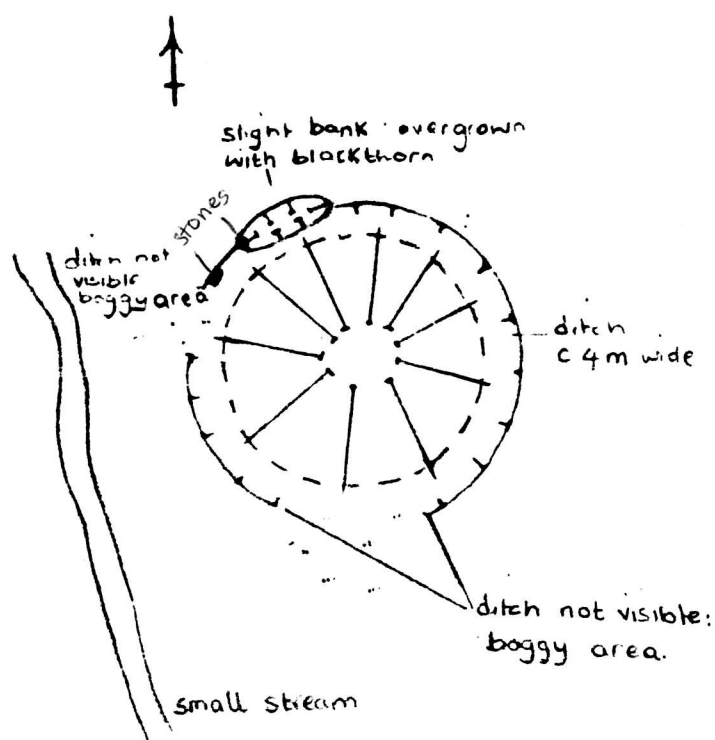


The Motte is still in a good state of preservation but overgrown with trees. It is surrounded by a silted up ditch ~0.3m deep and ~4.0m wide but is not continuous all around the motte where there are wet, boggy areas. Slight bank. The field is quite wet and has an irregular surface, possibly due to old stream courses.

Mr Maccartney told us that they had plans to build in this field, but land within 30m radius from ^{the} crown of the motte was to be left untouched.
