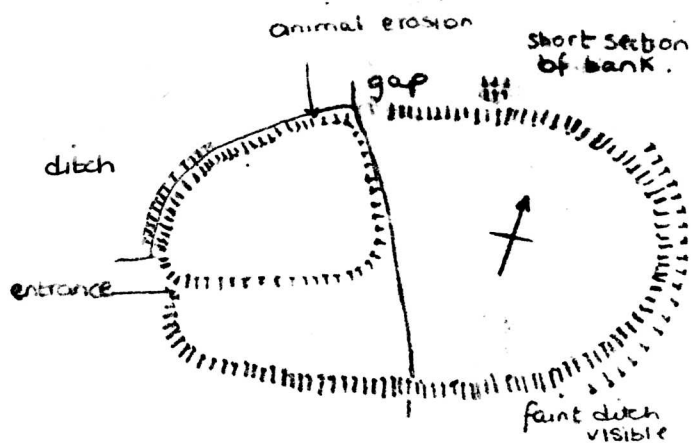


Castell y Graes is a concentric hill-slope enclosure divided into two by a NW-SE hedge. It is univallate with traces of an outer ditch to the east and to the NW of inner enclosure. There is a small section of outer bank to the north.

There is an inner enclosure in the NW corner. Its north bank has suffered some animal erosion. The building material consisting of earth and small stones.

There appears to be an entrance on the west side, and a gap on the north side, presumably to allow access to the interior for agricultural purposes.
