

COMMENT	AUTHORITY
Cottage observed in passing, 12-3-85, only half of which remains standing.	JL / CMS
Single storey, two rooms, central entrance, lean to at one end ie 	
Walls - solid construction with founding layer of large boulders. Front wall - irregular pieces of stone laid roughly in courses, on this founding layer, with mud mortar. Side walls and back wall - clom - mud mixed with straw and shaley gravel on a stone plinth.	
Whole constructed on a stone platform built into hillside, in walled enclosure	
Roof - gabled - probably thatched - now corrugated iron - on A frame timbers.	
Ginnery - no trace - probably internal + lateral.	
Colourwashed - pink, croloft likely but no evidence for one.

6S-10 → NE front of cottage
