Entrenchment

This work extends from Porth Llong across the headland to Porth Melgan. It is composed of stone walling like Carn Fawr near Strumble Head, Pembrokeshire, and Castell Coch near Llandilo, Carmarthenshire. On the inside of the work near an entrance are several hut circles, and one very distinct cell, or sentry box, in the wall. Both the northern and southern extremities of the fortification are faintly drawn, especially on the Porth Melgan side. A piece of natural rock is introduced near the centre. Two if not three extended lines of walling project from the entrenchment across the valley.

Boundary approximately 5m wide,
comprising massive stones & rubble.
