

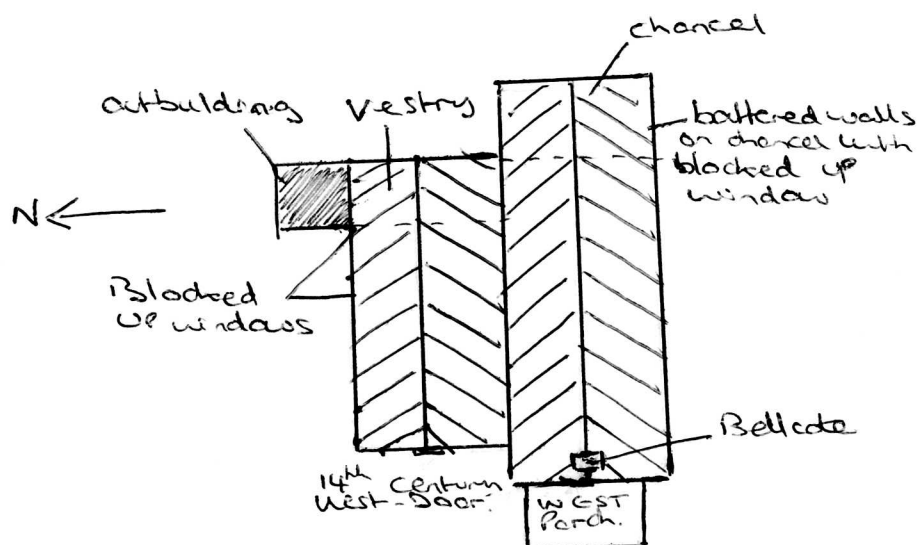
## ST Cynwyl's church (St Michael's)

14<sup>th</sup> century church with  
Post-medieval reconstruction.

The original 14<sup>th</sup> century west doorway  
still survives as does a probable  
Piccinia and the base of the  
Font which has been incorporated  
into the Arcade wall.

The church has 7 16<sup>th</sup> century square  
headed windows, two of them  
blocked up in the northern wall  
of the N. Aisle, 3 Gothic windows  
all of them being of stained glass.  
The church also has a wooden  
barrelled roof which was constructed  
in c. 1863. The church also has  
tiled & wooden floors and a  
rather ornate Bellcote of Gothic (?)  
date. Some of the original stone  
work can still be seen inside the  
church, although re-pointed.
