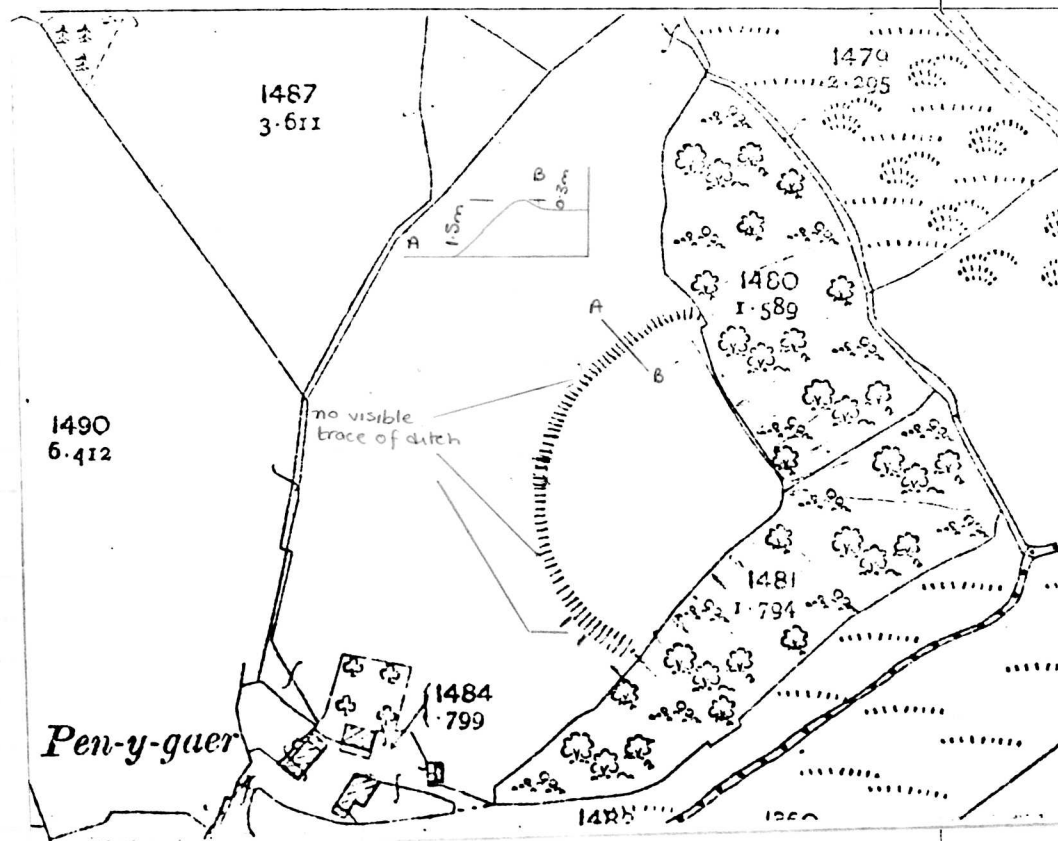


The fort is defended on the east side by steep natural slopes and on the west side by semicircular ramparts. These are much ploughed down, the best preserved area being to the N. the ditch is visible at the northern and southern end of the fort. There is some slight animal erosion and blackthorn growth on the NW bank.
