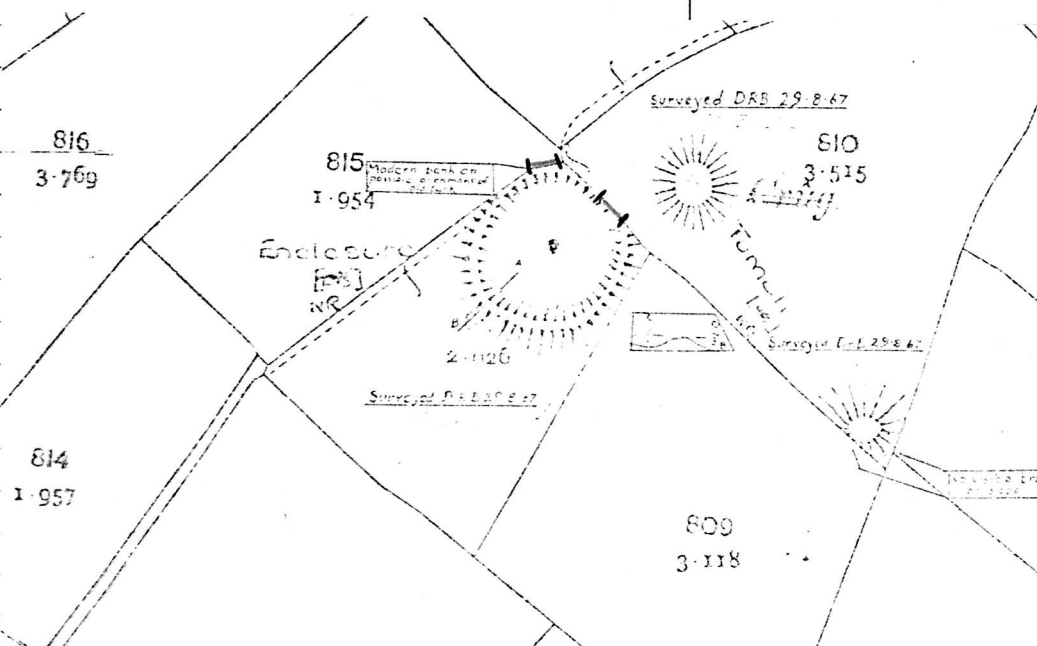


Site visited 29th September 1982.



H points of access

The point of access on the north-east side of the field into field no. 810 cuts through the bank of 2270 to a depth of about 10-15 cms.

Nothing was seen in the sections close to this site and incorporated into the hedge bank were many white quartz pebbles.

Garnfawr circle is situated at the north east end of a pasture field. The bank is most clearly visible on the SW side being 0.7m high and 11m wide. A gateway cuts the bank on the north east side and some gravel has been dumped at the entrance. A tractor path extends across the enclosure.
