

Following a telephone call from Mr Heath of Penrhinlas on 5-3-1984 a field visit was made on 7-3-1984.

Penrhinlas was a farm complex the main building of which has recently been demolished. It consisted of a long single storey structure constructed of stone and thatched although the thatch had been covered ~~up~~ over with corrugated iron. The structure was divided into the laethly, byre and house with the laethly and the byre at either end of the house. The house itself consisted of two rooms ranged about a central passage, with lateral chimneys. The passage walls were partitions constructed of briar + clay and a croglot was present.

A stone object was also found by Mr Heath. It is partially dressed and presumably unfinished. Its purpose or date are not known.
