

A round barrow in the middle of Nant Gwynn Forest. c. 16.0m in diameter and 0.9m high. Large mutilation on west side. Mound heavily overgrown with gorse + heather and covered with fallen trees.

AS Maull 16-2-84

A smaller mound lies 6m to the south. This is interpreted as a modern spoil heap by the OS ① but seems to be the third barrow scheduled by the WO ②. whose scheduling includes it under a. and whose map only marks 2306 and 2307. under 109 (SAM No.). The OS third barrow is listed as being at SN36403268 (from RCAHM coords ③) but can not be identified by the OS from AP's ④ or on a field visit. This could not be located on DAT field visit either ⑤. It seems likely that this 'spoil heap' 6m south of PRN 2306 is the third barrow referred to and that the RCAHM have quoted the wrong coordinates.
