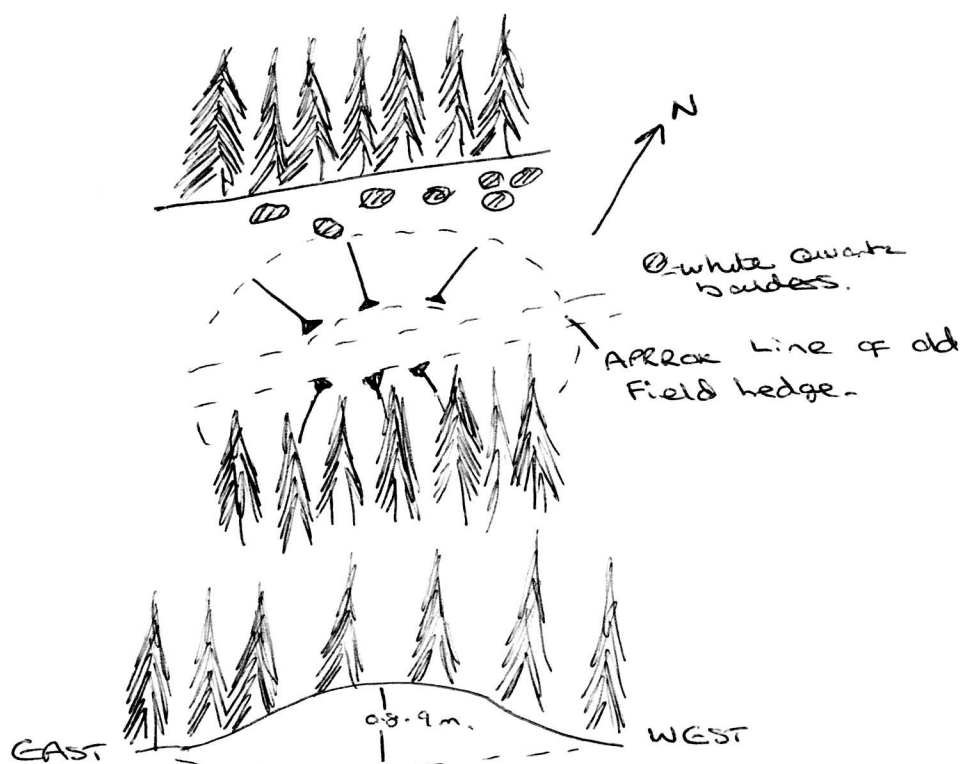


Can we find barrow 0.8-0.9m high. The remains of a badly mutilated round barrow standing inside Blackhead wood. An old field hedge use to run approx E-W across the mound, but was removed quite recently by a S.C.B. machine, causing a great deal of damage. Taking the top of the barrow and moving several large white quartz boulders immediately to the north of the barrow to the side of a fire break. These could either be from the old field hedge or from the barrow. The southern most part of the barrow is obscured by coniferous trees.
