Consisting of chancel and nave; restored in 1877; in beautiful situation above the West Cleddau. Double bell cote on west, with one bell mounted; holy water stoup in porch, with cross beneath. The porch, which is on the south, has stone-arched roof; part of the old font has been worked into the new one; inside and outside the church are monuments to the Wogans and Fords of Stonehall. In the chancel the top of elaborate cross from churchyard has been fixed to wall; there is another cross from outside, east of church, loose, with groove. Old stone, undecipherable, below altar. Ledge at back of altar, all along east end, a foot high.
