On the other side of the valley whose beauties have been ruined by the Great Western Railway, there is a deep precipice on the north, also on the east. The position is very strong. The mound on the south begins from the rock, and the natural rock has been used in many places. Internal measurements are 67 yards from east to west; 69 yards from north to south. On the south and west the bank is outside 25 feet high, with a trench all round where there is no precipice, and there are traces of an outer bank on the sides.
