

Was part of Stradley Estate.

Approached over an overgrown
farm trackway, about 1/2 mile from
the main road.

The ruins of a farmstead, situated in
a hollow at the edge of woodland.

The rear wall is built into the corner
SW bank of the field. A trackway
runs in front of the building
from the NW to SE.

The remains of the farmstead consists
of rubble stone walls, standing
approx 2 metres high at the rear
where the walls are built into the
bank. There are five rectangular
buildings evident.
