

The earthwork showed up very faintly on Aerial Photograph but on every visit until today the features have been almost indiscernible. Winter growth conditions, however, have made it very obvious.

It is quite a large structure on nearly level ground and is on the valley floor (? unusual).

The eastern border is incorporated into the field boundary, the northern is the bank that slopes steeply to the Nant-y-coy stream.

It occupies the NE corner of the 3rd field in from the wood surrounding the mill.
