A double camp with a precipice on the south-east. There are traces of an outer work on the north-west round both camps- they slope to the south-east. The bank in both camps is 15 feet outside and 5 feet inside. The outer camp is on the south-west; the inner camp is, from south-west to north-east, 66 yds; from north-west to south-east 42 yds; the outer, from south-west to north-east, 33 yds; from north-west to south-east, 30 yds.
