The four walls were standing in living memory; now everything has gone except a massive arch, upon which large trees are growing. The hedges of the yard are down. There is a flat slab, on the ground in the chancel, to David Morse of Rinaston, and Martha his wife, who were buried there in 1785 and 1789 respectively, after the church was disused.
