Church 2423

Dedicated to St. Ismael. The so-called piscina seemed to us rather the remains of a window. There are stone seats in the chancel and slight remains of a rood-loft. Good font with cushioned sides. Curious arrangement in the tower for overlooking the interior of the church; it has two very small squints. (See Arch. Camb. IV, VIII, 214; Fenton, 154).

Visited Feb. 85: Several gravestones are decaying badly. The stonework around the southern doorway looks ~~for~~ worthy of examination of GPs. Tower appears to have suffered considerable frost-damage this winter.
