Is below a slope and above a steep hill on the west. It is circular. The bank has been much levelled. The diameter is 25 yds; the bank on the south-east and round to the north is about 8 ft deep outside; the trench is 5 ft wide at the bottom, and in places on the far side old stone has been worked in. There is a spring of water 60 yards away on the south-east.
