About 100 yards south of the church are the remains of the Hospice from which the place takes its name (called in Latin HOSPITALE). It belonged to the Cathedral, and is said to have been founded by Bishop Beck. All that remains of this ancient building is a small space enclosed between four walls, some 15 yards long by 6 wide. No details have survived. A good deal of it was pulled down about 30 years ago to build the modern farmhouse.
