

Church 9641-2 2524-5

The place is in Welsh Tremarchog; in Latin Villa Cameraree. See Owen's Pembrokeshire, I, 520. This ancient church is described in Arch. Camb. IV, xiv, 344 and V, v, 131. There are 3 inscribed stones in the chancel; for one see Arch. Camb. III, ii, 49 and V, xiii, 302. The 2 others have recently been placed there by the Pembs. Association for the Preservation of Ancient Monuments. In the old font are the remains of what may have been a piscina, lately found in the churchyard.
