The church was entirely rebuilt in 1856. For the incised stone in the churchyard, see Westwood Lap. Wal. p.133, and his article in the Arch. Camb. IV, xiv, 325. See also Arch. Camb. V, i, 146. King John landed at Fishguard from Ireland on 26th August 1210. The manor belonged to the Crown until early in the last century. In the Cambrian Register, I, 240, there is a "Statistical Account of the Parish of Fishguard" written by Richard Fenton.
