Mr. Henry Owen, F.S.A. in Pembroke County Guardian, 25.1.1896 says "Castle Maurice had its name from Maurice Fitz-Gerald the brother of Bp David and the uncle of Gerald of Manorbier, the most famous of Pembrokeshire men. It appears from the Cartulary of St. David's that Sir John Wogan of Picton, when he founded his chantry in 1302 procured grants of the manor of Castle Maurice from the heirs of Maurice Fitz-Gerald, who were then resident in Ireland." Some years ago when removing a mound of earth from the farmyard at this place the skeleton of a man was found.
