See Arch. Camb. 1897, p. 424. Mr. E. Laws in Little England, p.359
says that "about 1818 gold coins of James I, Charles I and Louis XIV
were found under an old window seat in Llangwarren House - On the
eve of the Battle of Waterloo some men were engaged here in remov-
ing a tumulus in close proximity to the house, when a Press Gang
came and impressed them for service, but on the receipt of the news
of the victory over Napoleon, the men were released. One of the
men impressed bore the name of Wilkin.
