South Hook, Herbrandston - SM 870054 - the area of South Hook Point now occupied by the 19th C. fort was known as 'Lower Lines' and a field to the north was named 'Ore Park'. Leased in 1785 for the working of lead and copper. Higher than average lead content in mussels and sand in locality appear to confirm existence of lead veins.
