1. Name - Reynalton Colliery (also Grid ref. SN 088087  
known as New Reynolton)

Parish - Reynalton

District - South Pems.

Anthracite colliery on east side of valley immediately south of parish church.

Disturbed ground to east of stream and to south-west of lane alongside church marks position of pumping shaft and two slants (all now filled). Railway, extension to Saundersfoot Railway, from colliery (earthworks only remaining); some walling and foundations remain at loading bay onto railway from Main Slant. Power House (intact) and Winding House (foundations only) for Main Slant survive in field immediately west of church.

Intermittent shallow working up to 1914. Worked in depth from Main Slant 1914 - 1921.
