Penarthur. The line of stones at this place, about 25 in number, and a bank running at right angles to them, occurring at the junction of the two Roman roads, led the writer to hope that he had found the site of Menapia. But upon examining the ground with Mr. Edward Laws it was decided that the remains were not Roman but prehistoric. In this field were discovered lumps of mortar and portions of dressed sandstone, but upon enquiring of the tenant of the farm it was found that they had been carted to the field from the yard of St. David's Cathedral. This is mentioned for the guidance of other explorers.
