The Market Cross. Mrs. Dawson, in the Pembroke County Guardian, says that it was customary to take the bodies of dead persons round this cross.

(14th cross retaining its octagonal shaft but with modern head on base of six stone steps. Restored eg by Bishop Thirlwall in mid 19th and in 1873. Scheduled ancient monument.

A wheel headed cross on an octagonal shaft set in a socket stone on top of six steps. The socket stone & steps are believed to be medieval and probably in situ.
