Archdeacon Yardley (temp. 1739) says there was a large building here in his time which he conjectured to have belonged to an Episcopal mill.

Originally mediaeval, rebuilt c. early 19th, restored 1931, still working. Attached 19th and later house. Small mill with stone rubble walls. Internally, stone flagged floor with ladder leading up to hoppers and grinding stones on platform at S-W end. Gallery loft against remaining three walls. Date stone partly inscribed "T. Roberts 1810".

Rebuilt outhouse with curved walls and cemented roof against S-E wall. Two-storey house with pebbledash cladding and slate gabled roof with stone flanking stacks. Sash windows three panes wide and four deep with later centre first floor window without glazing bars, central ledged door.
