The peninsula is protected by a single vallum and ditch.

This site is multivallate, with the outer promontory protected by three or four ramparts (very denuded). Further inland a single bank and ditch cuts off the outer promontory from the mainland. There is possibly another lost ditch between this and the mainland, which has been quarried away.

The defences are suffering severe erosion a combination of their location on a narrow neck of land; coastal and visitor erosion. Murphy 1996.
