Llanddinog

Site of ancient Chapel 2742

Dinah Jenkins (formerly Wilkin) who died at the age of 93, about the year 1863, remembered seeing the remains of a building - (traditionally stated to have been a church) - in the field now known as WYR-GLODD Y FYNWENT, opposite Llanddinog dwelling-house. The name of the field would imply that there was at least a burial ground here. It is stated by James Davies, joiner, Solva, that about 40 years ago before the present cattle-houses were built, there was a stone in one of the fold-gate jambs bearing an incised cross and an inscription. The place-name is probably derived from St. Dyfanog.
