| 4 legs which have fallen under the great weight. The capstone of the |
| adjacent cromlech measures 15ft x 10ft by 5ft thick and partly rests |
| on underlying stones. Upon a cursory glance these cromlechs would |
| appear to be a collection of boulders, but upon examination it will |
| be found that the capstones are not of the character of the rock |
| found in situ, and their angularity prove them to be other than |
| erratic boulders. |
