The birthplace of Bishop Adam Houghton, Lord Chancellor of England, Jones & Freeman, p. 232. The stone-work referred to is to be found in the front wall of the stable opposite the dwelling-house. An exhaustive search failed to discover any other remains. It is conjectured that the stable formed part of a chapel. This house was the property of a member of the Perrot family at the beginning of the 16th century. Perrot Notes, 29, 75.
