Mr. John Gibbon, who was born here and occupied the farm for 60 yrs, informed the writer that it was a tradition in his family that before the fields were enclosed the farm was a sheep-walk, and that the rounding up was at the three Meini Hirion - hence the name Tremaenhir, or more correctly TRIMAENHIR. Two of these monoliths remain, one still standing in the hedge bounding the haggard, the other recumbent on the opposite side of the road.
