Fenton, 142. The castle mound is surrounded by a ditch, and the remains of a well are to be seen on the north summit of the mound. About 40 years ago Mr. Essex Griffiths dug into the tump, and found (so one of his grandchildren informed the writer) several bronze coins. A stone has also been found in the mound, on which was inscribed A TAU CROSS, the incision being about 1 in deep and the cross about 7 ins long.
