We were fortunate in our visit, J.W. Philipps Esq., M.P., owner of this Castle was doing such repairs as are required to prevent the collapse of the building. To carry out this necessary restoration scaffolds and ladders were erected to the summit, and for the first time we were enabled to enjoy the wonderful panorama. Though the day was not clear we could recognise St. David's, Pembroke, Caldy Priory, the Race Course (Tenby) and many other places.
