It has been suggested that this church stands in a circular earth-work, as does the church of Eglwys Cymmin in Carmarthenshire, but though the yard is elevated above its surroundings and in some parts adjoining a deep lane, the evidence is inconclusive. The church is dedicated to St. Mary; there is nothing of interest therein excepting the head of a canopied cross, figured on four sides; Crucifixion, Good Shepherd, Virgin and Child, and a Bishop.
