St. Ismael was a nephew of St. Teilo, and by him appointed as a suffragan of Menevia. Rees' Welsh Saints, 252. St. Caradoc, the latest of the Welsh saints, was said to have resided here. This appears to be an error, which arose from the fact that Haroldstone Church, near Haverfordwest, was dedicated to St. Ishmael. The church was described by Sir Stephen Glyn, Bart., Arch. Camb. V, ii, 210.
