Drilled Stone Disc 3045

In Tenby Museum. Found by Mr. Sinnett, the tenant, and given by him to H. Mathias Esq. who presented it to the Museum. This object is about 2½ ins in diameter, bevelled at different angles on both sides towards the hole in the centre. Its purpose is unknown, possibly an ornament or amulet. There is a somewhat similar stone in the Rivet Carnac Collection, British Museum. Mr. Sinnett found another stone just like this one, but threw it away. We may hope some day it may be re-found.
