Angle

Cliff Castle 3065

Consists of a bank 70 yards long and 45 feet high (above the bottom of the outside ditch) running across the narrow neck of the headland. There is a gap through the bank and a ditch on the south side; the outside ditch is about 6 feet deep. Inside are two shallow ditches running parallel to the bank, and at the point is a shallow depression from which a narrow path leads to the outside headland (which will be an island shortly). Here is some slight trace of walling, probably modern. The headland is covered with curious pits some 15 to 20 feet long, 8 feet broad 4 to 5 feet deep, arranged in no particular order.
