This is called RAM'S CASTLE by George Owen (see Owen's Pembrokeshire I, 108) and Roman's Castle by the Ordnance map. It commands an extensive view, being on the highest point in the locality, which lies low. The inside measurements are: from north to south 77 yards and from east to west 68 yards. The inner bank is about 10 feet high but has been levelled in part towards the west. There is an outer bank nearly 22 feet high, which has been levelled on the south and west; between the banks is a deep ditch. Arch. Camb. III, x, 346; V, xv, 181.
