This has long been desecrated; in Fenton's time it was used as a powder magazine. Even the graveyard, which can be distinctly traced is trampled on. The west end of the chapel is open and many stones have been taken from the outside of the north wall. It has a nave with a vaulted roof, and a chancel which is lower. There is an east window; also windows on the north and south of the chancel and of the nave; the door was on the north of the nave. All the windows are now built up; the piscina remains.
