

DAT informed of farmers plan to put drainage in rath area - message received 4.30pm Thurs Feb 15th 1979. Site visited by N. Edwards on Friday 16th. Mr Smith - owner said he had put it in 1 week before. A single trench of perhaps 0.5m wide x 1m deep x 100m long had been cut right across the rath and had been refilled. The length of trench was clearly visible crossing the rath and would undoubtedly have provide some information on the bank on ditch. The rath was still under plunging and was perhaps 1/2 - 3/4 m at its highest profile. No finds were apparent from a more than cursory examination of the trench length.
