

Holy Well 3310-11

This is outside the north-east corner of the outer ring and within the outer rampart; it has been lately restored by Mr. Henry Owen, D.C.L. of Poyston. The walls of the chapel just below the well were standing in living memory. Fenton, p. 357, says that in the grant to the Commandery of Slebech it was called CASELLA SANCTI LEONARDI DE CASTRO SYMONIS.
