- The name is a duplicate, not uncommon in this district, of the
 - Welsh LLEATHER and the English HILL. Here was the house of the
 - Haward, a cheshire family whose scion married the heiress of the
 - Goddards. George Haward was Sheriff during the Protectorate. The
 - family were liberal benefactors to Haverfordwest. From the ruins
 - which are left, and from the site, it is evident that the house
 - was of no great extent. At the end of the 18th century Flether Hill
 - belonged Jure Uxoris to Sir Watkin Lewes, the Pembrokehire Lord
 - Mayor of London.
