

There was a school in the Church of St Thomas at Haverfordwest from quite an early date, although we first hear of it when Richard Smith MA. was appointed schoolmaster in 1488, and was authorised to issue licences to other schoolmasters within a circumference of 7 miles of this town....

At the dissolution, the revenues of St Thomas's Church fell into private hands, the school declined, & towards the close of the 16th had almost ceased to exist."

... In 1613 a new school was housed in the old school building, i.e. the Church of St Thomas.
