Merlin's Bridge

The chapel of St. Mary Magdalen gave the name to the bridge and hill now corrupted into Merlin's. Only the north wall of the chancel with three bays for lancet windows remains. There is a large walled garden adjoining, with high walls partly built of old bricks, said to have been made in the valley below.

These comprise part of the north wall of a small building now incorporated into an outhouse in the grounds of Bryn Merlin.
