Tumulus

The Bronze age tumulus. Opened by Fenton, and described in his book, page 237.

Excavated by Fenton - 1800 AD

Urn 'close underneath surface' cist, beneath aggregate of stones, lined with a soft soil of clay with half calcined bones, charcoal and a flint 'with the broad end grown smooth' Circumference (at present) 300 ft

Dia 41 m.

Height 6 ft 1 m.

Pigmy cup covered by then

Flagsone cist, lined with clay cremation + Flint E001
